

Webelos Extended Camp: What to bring: Suggested items

- Footlocker or large Tupperware tub for everything (waterproof – animal proof)
- Day pack
- Class ‘A’ Uniform(s) / neckerchief & hanger for tent (will be worn each night – multiples if you have)
- Class ‘B’ Uniform(s) (Blue and/or Orange – multiples if you have)
- Pants (short and long)
- Sweatshirts or light jacket
- Daily change of underwear +1 in case of rain! (4 pair)
- Daily change of socks +1 in case of rain (4 pair)
- Comfortable shoes/sneakers for hiking/walking – **No open toed shoes**
- Shoes that can get wet (in lake/ creek) - This is an additional pair of shoes.
- Sleepwear
- Pillow
- Sleeping bag and bunk pad
- Toothbrush & toothpaste
- Drinking cup
- Washcloth
- Swimsuit x 2
- Towel x 2 (they do not always dry overnight)
- Comb, brush, & soap
- Flashlight and extra batteries (many find a headlamp preferable)
- Webelos handbook
- Paper and pencil or notebook
- Raincoat or poncho
- Hat
- Sunscreen & bug repellent
- Water bottle
- Money for trading post (10 dollars should be enough)
- Warm socks – preferably NOT cotton – in case of cold or wet
- Laundry bag – such as a garbage bag
- Plastic bags /zip-lock bags for wet clothes/towels in day pack
- Rope for clothesline in or between tents

Webelos Exended Camp: Important Information

Class 'A' Uniform is **required** to be worn at **arrival** to camp as well as at each **dinner** and evening **flag ceremonies**. If you have more than one Class 'A' shirt please bring it. The scouts will need to keep their uniforms relatively presentable the 3 nights at camp.

Class 'B' Uniform is worn all other times.

We will meet at AELC on Sunday about Noon (subject to change) and arrive shortly after 1pm at HMSR. You may travel directly to HMSR but try to arrive prior to 3pm – if you are NOT meeting at AELC please inform the trip leader. Families are expected to travel to camp Sunday and pick-up on Wednesday unless private arrangements are made with another family.

Upon arrival at camp Sunday the trip leader must register the pack prior to getting the campsite assignment; therefore all scouts/parents must stay in the parking lot. Cars will be allowed to drive to the campsite to deliver gear so it does not need to be walked into camp.

Swim Test – if you did not take the swim test and want to take it at camp, ensure your swim suit and towel is with you upon arrival at camp – you will go to the pool prior to setting up camp – **DO NOT LEAVE YOUR SUIT IN YOUR LOCKER** if you want to take the swim test.

Tuesday evening is the campfire program – all parents/family members are encouraged to attend. Last year program started at 8pm.

Please let the trip leader know of any potential issues with the following:

- First time away from home
- Rowing & swamping a boat in the lake

Wednesday morning pickup will be about 9:30 or 10am at camp. The scouts will wake, have breakfast, pack, and clean the campsite prior to checking out.

We will try to arrange a stop at War-Har Farm for ice cream on the way home.

Scouts may bring snacks, however, no food will be allowed in the tents. All food/snacks will be kept in the campsite pavilion – **no exceptions**.

Have a plastic bag for wet clothes in the daypack – often we will leave the pool and go to the dining hall and/or an event before returning to the campsite.

Sleeping arrangements – all campsites have 2 person canvas wall tents on wood platforms. Military style cots are provided in the tents. We would like the scouts to bunk with each other since that is what will be required when they attend as Boy Scouts. However, if a scout's parent is attending they may bunk together if desired.
